

## **Behavior Management and Intervention for Students**

It is the policy of the board to promote good behavior in a safe and orderly environment where all students can be fully engaged in the learning process. To ensure that our students and staff are protected against disruptive behavior, the board directs the superintendent, or designee, to set forth procedures for behavior management and interventions that are designed to maintain a positive environment conducive to learning.

If the student has an Individualized Education Program (IEP), the process will follow federal and state laws governing special education.

Student conduct expectations are detailed in each school's Student/Parent Handbook.
