

INDOOR AIR QUALITY PROGRAM

The board directs the superintendent to address methods of minimizing or eliminating emissions from buses, cars, delivery vehicles, and other motorized vehicles. The superintendent may delegate the implementation of these methods to building administrators.

In addition to addressing methods eliminating emissions, building principals are directed to annually investigate air quality within their respective school buildings using the checklist provided to the school by the New Hampshire Department of Education.

Drivers are to turn off their vehicle's engine when parked to drop off or pick up students.

Bus providers and delivery vehicles are to follow anti-idling procedures when loading or unloading.

Exceptions may be made for extreme weather conditions which require idling for heating, mechanical purposes, or to ensure full functioning of safety lights and equipment.
