

WORLD LANGUAGES PROGRAM

It is the policy of the School Board to provide students with opportunities to explore a broad range of academic fields. In keeping with the developmental needs of students, a world language program will be offered to students in the middle school and high school.

Content will follow the adopted curriculum. Instruction will include vocabulary, speaking, reading, listening skills, and writing skills. The curriculum will also include cultural components.

Students who demonstrate content mastery at the exploratory level may be offered the opportunity to participate in a more intensive instructional program.

As resources permit, the district will also make an effort to teach foreign language in the elementary grades.
