

**RELATIONS WITH COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS**

The school board views community organizations as groups of citizens sincerely interested in the advancement of the community, including its public schools. The school board seeks to support community organizations whose purposes are to function as one of the following:

- a liaison between the community and the school system;
- a resource to the schools and its students;
- a means to assist in the provision of instructional aids for the classroom;
- a study groups to assist in evaluating a particular issue.

In accepting assistance from any particular community organization, the group is reminded that the school board must represent the entire community rather than any single group.
